Spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ

We are thankful for continued growth in the ministry of Catholic education and the opportunity to spread the Gospel to more children every year.

- Healthy, sustainable enrollment with 155 students (ranging from 3K through grade 8).
- Prayer, religious education, and reinforcement of Gospel teachings on a daily basis in classrooms.
- Sacramental preparation for second-graders in First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation.

High Quality Education

Catholic school students consistently outperform their peers on state and national standardized tests. And that includes Holy Trinity.

- 90% of Holy Trinity middle school students earned academic honors in the 2017-2018 school year.
- Two-thirds of Holy Trinity alumni graduating from high school in 2018, did so with honors.
- Many eighth-graders take high school subjects, such as English 9, algebra, or geometry.

Living the Catholic faith

Holy Trinity students live their Catholic faith in their daily activities.

- Students actively planned and participated in more than 30 weekly Masses, observed liturgical seasons, and practiced serving others.
- Students conducted community outreach to the Kewaskum Food Pantry and Kettle Moraine Gardens, made contributions to the Christmas Child, and made Valentines for shut-ins.

2017-2018 School Highlights

Nearly 70% increase in enrollment over the past 5 years.

- Over 100 families put their trust in Holy Trinity to educate their children.
- The new parish center, complete with gymnasium, kitchen, and cafeteria, is utilized to its fullest. The vital parishes of Holy Trinity and St. Michael have put their faith in future generations with this very generous gift.
