Spotlight Theatre group out of West Bend is performing Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat.

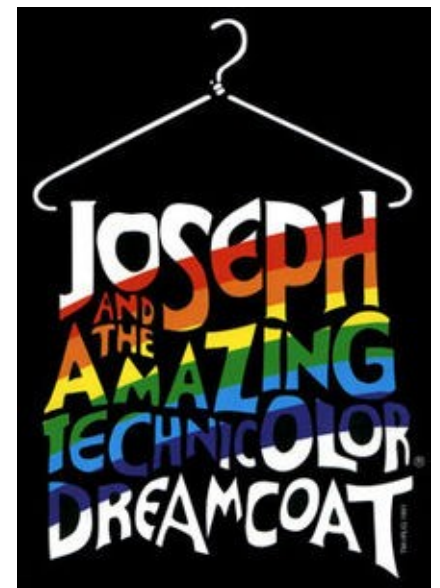
October 6th, 7th, 8th & 13th 14th and 15th.
