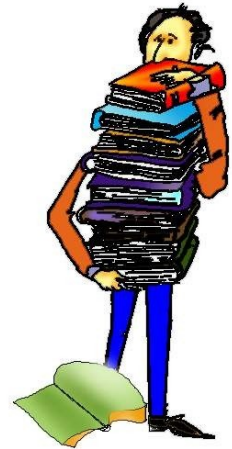

Party On The Pavement

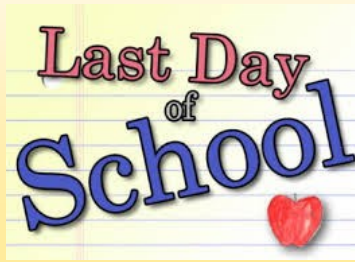
