During this Christmas Season, the Church observes so many wonderful feast days and celebrations! Between the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, and the Epiphany, we celebrate today the feast of the Most Holy Name of Jesus! This is another way for the Church to call our attention to Jesus' identity, and to encourage us to call upon him.

When Gabriel visited Mary, the angel told her, "Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus." Similarly, the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and explained Mary's virgin conception. "You are to name him Jesus," the angel told Joseph, "because he will save his people from their sins."

Jesus' name literally means "savior." St. Paul writes to the Philippians that "God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

In the Acts of the Apostles, the name of Jesus healed the lame and brought the dead back to life, and we conclude all of our prayers as a Church by praying in the name of Jesus Christ, for he promised that "whatever you ask the Father in my name he will give you" (John 16:23).

We are so blessed here at Holy Trinity School to be able to pray in Jesus' name every day, asking Him to grant us the grace we need most! I encourage you, as a family, to call on Jesus and ask Him to bless you and all that you do!

*Here is the special section, where each week, I will share information about what “Standards-Based Learning and Assessment” means, what it will look like for your child, and why we are making the change.*

### **How does SBG change the way my child experiences learning?**




SBG provides parents and students with specific feedback on each learning standard. Since the focus of instruction is on mastery for students, they will have more than one opportunity to demonstrate mastery, if and when it is needed. Feedback from assessments tell students what learning goals they have mastered and what they still need to work on. Students “own” their learning which creates a culture of learning that is more engaging for students and embraces learning as the goal.

### **Will SBG change the curriculum?**

No. The curriculum of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee is designed to be standards-based and has always been aligned with state and national standards.


