HTS is celebrating another year of growth. We are thankful the ministry of Catholic education is expanding, giving us the opportunity to spread the Gospel to more children each year.

- 8% increase in enrollment in the 2015/2016 school year - 113 students (ranging from 3K through grade 8).
- Prayer, religious education, and reinforcement of Gospel teachings on a daily basis in classrooms.

## **High Quality Education**

Holy Trinity School continues its rich tradition of quality education.

- 90% of middle school students earned academic honors or high-honors in the 2015/2016 school year.
- Rhea Dricken, grade 7, won 1st place in the district Modern Woodmen Speech Contest and went on to the state level competition.
- Alexandria Krueger and Meghan Luedtke (HTS class of 2012) graduated as co-Salutatorians - KHS Class of 2016, continuing a long tradition of top honors among HTS alumni.

Students live their Catholic faith at HTS. They have the opportunity to apply their religious education in their daily activities.

- Students were actively involved in planning and participating in more than 30 weekday Masses
- Students conducted community outreach to the Kewaskum Food Pantry and Kettle Moraine Gardens Assisted Living

## **2016-2017 School Highlights**

The 2016-2017 school has brought new growth for HTS.

- 39% increase in enrollment for a total of 158 students
- 108 families put their trust in Holy Trinity to educate their children
- A new parish center, complete with a kitchen, cafeteria, and gymnasium was dedicated in September by the archbishop. The vital parishes of Holy Trinity and St. Michael's have put their faith in future generations with this very generous gift.
