Book Fair Time has Arrived!

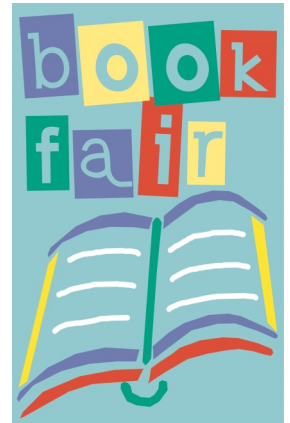
Please see the flyer in the folder with information about the book fair sale hours and book ideas. Your child will also attend with their class. We will be doing the classroom coin challenge again this year.

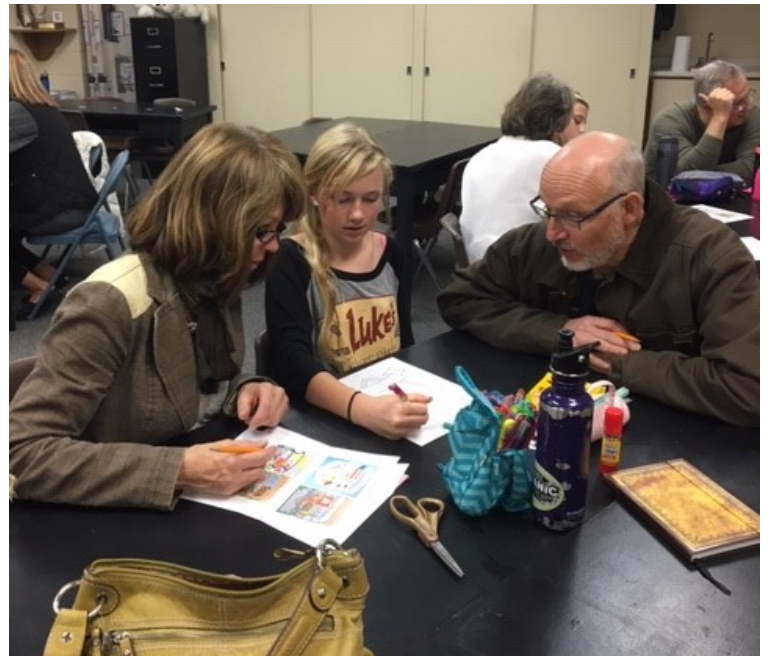
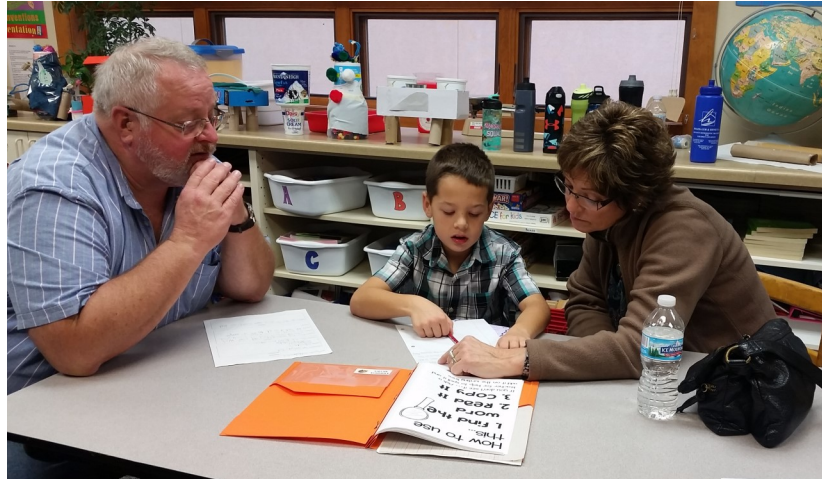


Thank you to all who came out to make this a good time. A special thanks to Mrs. Pasbrig and Mrs. Zillmer for spearheading this event.
